# Intertie Management Committee Resolution No. 22-01

Approval of Transfer of Certain State – Owned Cantwell Substation Assets

## INTRODUCTION

The Intertie Management Committee (IMC) is responsible for the management, operation, maintenance, and improvement of the Alaska Intertie Project (Alaska Intertie), subject to the non-delegable duties of the Alaska Energy Authority (AEA). On June 23, 1988, AEA transferred AEA's right title and interest in the Cantwell Distribution Line to Golden Valley Electric Association (GVEA). AEA and GVEA are entering into an Asset Transfer Agreement for certain other equipment in the Cantwell Substation, and are seeking the IMC's approval.

# PURPOSE OF IMC RESOLUTION 22-01

This IMC Resolution 22-01 provides the consent of the IMC to the Asset Transfer Agreement of the equipment listed in attached Exhibit A. It specifically excludes certain assets identified in Exhibit A.

## **IMC RESOLUTION NO. 22-1**

WHEREAS, The Intertie Management Committee is responsible for the management, operation, maintenance, and improvement of the Alaska Intertie Project (Alaska Intertie), subject to the non-delegable duties of AEA.

WHEREAS, AEA and GVEA have entered into an Asset Transfer Agreement for certain AEA owned assets listed in Exhibit A, and incorporated herein by this reference.

WHEREAS, AEA and GVEA have requested that the IMC approve the proposed Asset Transfer Agreement that include certain assets and exclude other listed assets in Exhibit A.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS RESOLVED THAT:

SECTION 1. The foregoing statements and recitals are incorporated herein as if fully set forth.

SECTION 2. The IMC approves the Asset Transfer Agreement between AEA and GVEA excluding only those assets that are to remain state-owned assets listed in Exhibit A.
