RE-VEEP Overview

- RE-VEEP is an expansion of the Village Energy Efficiency Program, which was established to help Alaska communities reduce per capita consumption and costs through energy efficiency.
- \$2.6 million in federal funding is available for sub-grants
- Funding Sources
 - Energy Efficiency and Conservation Block Grant (EECBG) Program (\$1.4 million)
 - State Energy Program: Bipartisan Infrastructure Law (\$1.2 million)



RE-VEEP Goals

RE-VEEP seeks to award subgrants to finance <u>building-scale renewable energy</u>, <u>energy efficiency</u>, and <u>conservation</u> projects in public buildings and facilities in rural Alaska.

- 2. Equity and Justice40
- 3. Workforce Development, Job Quality and Wealth Creation



RE-VEEP Sub-Grant Awards




Sub-grants awarded are expected to:

Eligible Projects

Communities may use grant funding for the following types of building-scale renewables, energy efficiency, and conservation projects:

- energy efficiency audits of public buildings and facilities,
- energy efficiency improvements to public buildings and facilities,
- implementation of energy conservation measures, and
- implementation of building-scale renewable energy projects.

Anticipated Timeline



Dates are subject to change based on the number and complexity of applications received.

- Application Deadline: February 27, 2024 at 4 p.m.
- Application Review: February 28 to March 29, 2024
- Notification of Awards: April 1, 2024
- Complete Sub-Grant Paperwork: April 1 to April 29, 2024
 Contingent upon AEA receiving all documents needed for award.
- Sub-grantee Support Period: April 29 to May 10, 2024
- Project Completion Deadline: September 30, 2026
- Final Reports and Grant Closeout: October to December 2026, if not completed sooner
